THE WINTHROP UNIVERSITY DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- Take college courses for *college credit only* (dual enrollment) or for *both high school AND college credit* (dual credit)
 - Note: Communicate with high school counselor prior to registration if interested in dual credit.
- Start building college credit for use upon entering a post-secondary institution.
- Take courses you cannot get through any other dual enrollment program.
- Become an engaged member in the Winthrop learning community.



ELIGIBILITY

- Requirements for high school students to be admitted and enroll
 - Junior or senior status
 - 3.0 high school GPA (SC Uniform Grading Scale)
 - Score of 22 on the ACT or combined 1050 on the SAT (or PSAT/PreACT equivalency)
- Individual courses may have specific requirements of higher test score or high school course completion



PROGRAM FEES

- \$495 program fee per up to 4 credit hours (this equals a 70% discount on the cost a traditional student pays).
 - \$545 for out-of-state students
 - Lottery funds are not eligible for use at 4-year institutions like Winthrop
- Lab fees are assessed on some courses to pay for consumable materials involved in their instruction (chemicals, special software, accompanists, etc.). These lab fees are displayed in the course offerings directory at the time of registration.
- The cost of textbooks and required materials will vary widely from course to course. (\$0-\$300).
- Parking decal can be purchased after admitted (if needed)



APPLICATION PROCESS

- Visit website for important dates!
- Students create an account and complete the dual enrollment application through their Winthrop portal (detailed instructions and screen shots available on the Winthrop Dual Enrollment program website).



APPLICATION PROCESS

(continued)

- Step 5 of the application instructions directs students to "submit supplemental items" including a permission form and citizenship verification.
- Permission and Verification Form (including parent or guardian and school counselor signatures)
 - Note: Modified permission form required every semester before registration
- Immunization form required after admitted.



APPLICATION PROCESS

(continued)

- The Winthrop Admissions Office will mail (yes, check your actual mailbox) students a decision letter.
- The notification will include next steps to take to officially become a Winthrop student.



AFTER ACCEPTANCE

- Students are assigned a Winthrop eight-digit ID number. The ID number is necessary for creating a **Winthrop email account**.
 - Note: After acceptance, the Winthrop email is the primary communication between the student and the university!
- The Winthrop email is required as a login to “Wingspan.” This is the university system for accessing academic and financial information.
- Students will also need a [Winthrop ID card](#) since it is required to enter many buildings, events, classrooms, and the library.



REGISTRATION

- It's all online.
- Accepted students view available courses paying close attention to pre-requisites then submit [interest survey](#) with course information.
- Course requests are sent to the appropriate department for approval then students are notified with registration information through WINTHROP EMAIL!
